She then completed her medical training and internship at Medical College of Georgia where she received the Puryear Academic Scholarship and was invited into Alpha Omega Alpha (the medical honor society for excellence in academic and clinical medicine).

She then went on to the nationally renowned ophthalmology department at University of Wisconsin in Madison for residency. After this, she completed a fellowship of cornea and refractive surgery at the University of Wisconsin. She then moved to the Chapel Hill area to complete a second fellowship in pediatric ophthalmology at the prestigious Duke Eye Center. While in training she published several scientific studies in medical journals and was contributing author to a pediatric ophthalmology textbook.

Triangle Ophthalmology, PA is located within Chapel Hill Doctors Integrative Health Center which is conveniently located in northern Chapel Hill, a ¼ mile from the intersection of Martin Luther King Blvd and Weaver Dairy Rd near I-40 in the Chapel Hill 40 office complex (formerly Vilcom Center) across from Timberlyne Shopping Center.

Please note that the sign within Boyd Hall will say “Chapel Hill Doctors” **not** Triangle Ophthalmology, PA.

Do not get directions from google! Please call if the below directions are not clear.

From I-40:

- Exit 266 (NC-86).
- Travel south on Martin Luther King Blvd towards Chapel Hill.
- Turn left onto Weaver Dairy Rd.
- Turn Left at first stop light into the Vilcom Center (Chapel Hill 40) office complex.

From Chapel Hill traveling north on Martin Luther King Blvd:

- Turn right onto Weaver Dairy Rd.
- Turn Left at first stop light into the Chapel Hill 40 office complex.

From 15/501 Traveling South from Durham:

- Turn Right onto Erwin Road.
- Turn Left onto Weaver Dairy Rd at stop light.
- Follow Weaver Dairy past East Chapel Hill High School and Carol Woods Retirement Community.
- Turn Right at first light after Carol Woods into the Chapel Hill 40 Office Complex on Vilcom Center Drive.

From 15/501 Traveling North from Chapel Hill:

- U-Turn off 15/501 and turn right onto Erwin Rd.
- Left onto Weaver Dairy Rd at stop light.
- Follow Weaver Dairy past East Chapel Hill High School and Carol Woods Retirement Community.
- Turn Right at first light past Carol Woods on Vilcom Center Dr. (Chapel Hill 40 office complex).

Boyd Hall is the brick office building on the right as you enter the Vilcom Center.

The Center is located on the first floor of Boyd Hall in Suite 110.

Note: The Center can be entered from the lobby or via the patio in the back of the building. The patio is located at the top of the walk-up ramp to the right of the building.
